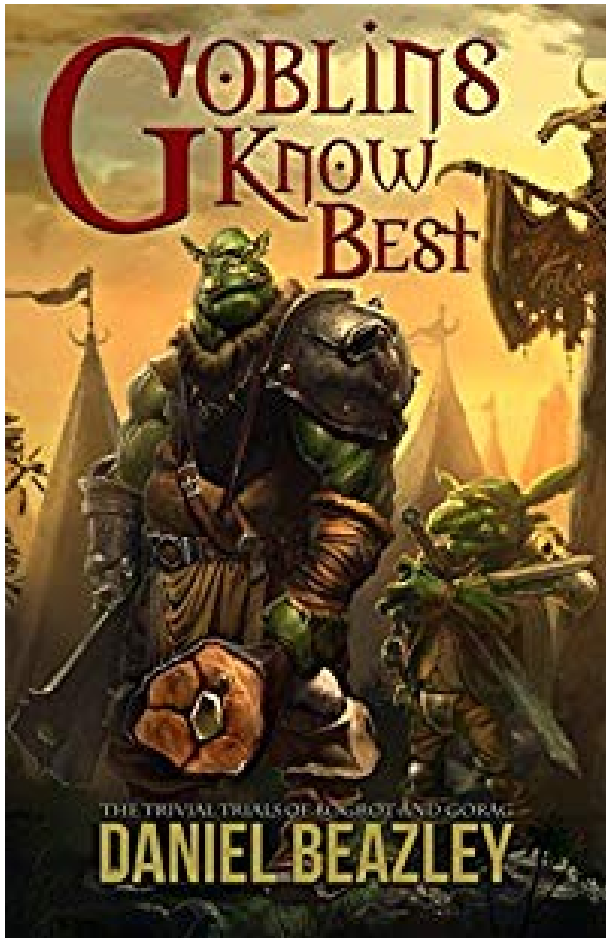

Goblins Know Best: The Trivial Trials of Bogrot and Gorag by Daniel Beazley, is a collection of connected short stories regarding the adventures of two unlikely adventuring partners, the cunning goblin, Bogrot Blisterfoot and the hulking orc, Gorag Bather. Bogrot is the narrator of eight short stories (plus a prologue and an epilogue) that recount his early, unfortunate association with the evil gnome, Barlek Chancer, and his subsequent friendship with the imposing orc, Gorag. Each of these brilliant stories stands on its own as a riotous adventure but they also demonstrate the strength of the bond between Bogrot and Gorag.

Whether facing down a gang of dwarf pirates or trying to return a baby dragon to its mother, each death-defying mission shows, in rich detail, how companionship and commitment breed courage in the face of overwhelming odds.
